They move slowly but resolutely towards goals and have a tendency to get stuck in the predictability of life.

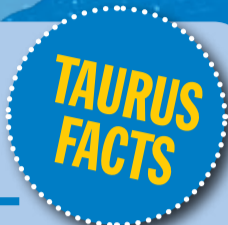
